MINUTES

Daniel Adams called the Budget Planning meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. starting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Following the pledge, a roll call of Town Board Members was conducted, Daniel Adams, Daniel Reischel, and Wayne Bowe were all present. Daniel Adams asked the Clerk to Verify that public notice of this meeting was made by Town Board. The Clerk reported that it was posted in front of the Town Hall, and at the Recycling center, along with being posted at Bresina's Bar and Baier's Bar. It was also posted on the Town's web page.

1. Daniel Adams started with a recap of the Oct. 24th WTA (Wisconsin Towns Association) meeting held at the Tilden Town Hall. Daniel Adams mentioned that the Town of Eagle Point received notice that the Railroad petitioned to close 95th Avenue and 105th Avenue. There was also a discussion about a new plow truck for the Road Department. The discussion included a question about borrowing money to buy the truck and its potential impact on the budget.
2. Discussion about the 2018 Budget continued with refinements being made to the proposed 2018 Budget.
3. The date to present the 2018 Budget to the Town's People was set for November 13, 2017 at 7:00 P.M at the Tilden Town Hall, a PUBLIC HEARING on the PROPOSED 2018 BUDGET of the Town of Tilden will be held. Immediately following the PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING there will be a SPECIAL MEETING of the TOWN OF TILDEN ELECTORS for the following purposes: To approve total highway expenditures for 2018 pursuant to Section 82.03 of Wisconsin Statutes and to approve the 2017 town tax levy to be paid in 2018 pursuant to sec. 60.10(1)(a) of Wis. Statutes. Then immediately following the SPECIAL MEETING of the TOWN OF TILDEN ELECTORS there will be a Town Board Meeting to: Adopt the 2017 levy to be collected in 2018 to adjourn the meetings.
4. Daniel Adams made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Daniel Reischel. Voice vote followed, motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 10:05 p.m.
